The family has been integral in launching several new initiatives and even chaired ALF's first Liver Life Walk in South Carolina in 2024.

### State Statistics

<b>1,088</b>	South Carolina residents died of liver disease/cirrhosis in 2022
<b>143</b>	liver transplants were performed in South Carolina
<b>96</b>	people are on the liver transplant waitlist
<b>11</b>	South Carolinians have died while on the liver transplant waitlist
<b>11.1%</b>	of adults in South Carolina have diabetes
<b>35.5%</b>	of adults in South Carolina are obese
<b>25%</b>	of adults have no leisurely physical activity

### ALF 2025 Legislative Priorities

- Increase funding for MASLD research and education
- Expand liver disease surveillance and prevention efforts at the CDC
- Finalize coverage for anti-obesity medication under Medicare Part D
- Support laws like the [Living Donor Protection Act](#), [Safe Step Act](#), [HOLD Act](#) and [HELP Copays Act](#)
- Improve access to liver disease treatments and reduce out-of-pocket costs
