Ron H.

Ron advocates to help raise awareness about the importance of organ donation. After he was diagnosed with liver cirrhosis, Ron fought more than eight months to be added to the liver transplant waitlist. Once listed, he waited only 21 days before receiving the gift of life.



Danae P.

Danae advocates to raise awareness about liver disease and help dispel negative stigma. While pregnant with her first child, Danae's skin turned yellow; she was told it would go away after giving birth, but it didn't. After multiple tests/procedures, Danae was diagnosed with IgG4, a rare autoimmune liver disease. She now lives with a stent to help her bile ducts drain and takes daily medication to hopefully avoid the need for a liver transplant.



David R.

David advocates to help raise awareness about the importance of organ donation and increasing living donor protections. David was diagnosed with primary sclerosing cholangitis (PSC) at age 49 and was given one year to live. Thanks to the selfless act of an altruistic living liver donor, David was given a second chance at life.
